Directions

From the south:

Leave the motorway (M6) at junction 22 and follow the signs for A75 Dumfries / Stranraer.

Follow the A75 towards Dumfries, on the fourth round about (with a blue pedestrian

bridge crossing over the road) take the fifth exit onto the A76 towards Stranraer. If you're on the right road, you'll pass a McDonalds on your left and an old bus stop with a rhinoceros on the roof on your right as you head away from Dumfries.

Follow the A76 through the village of Holywood to Auldgirth.

Turn right off the A76 into Auldgirth village, you should be able to see the local pub The Auldgirth Inn to your left as you turn off the A76. Turn immediately left as though heading towards the Inn. In between the Inn and the Village hall is a single-track road that runs straight up the hill, follow this road, and as you go over the humpback railway bridge, you'll be able to see the farm.

Turn right into the farm through the grey gates and veer left into the main farmyard where you can park. Please watch out for our free ranging chickens and any other mischievous livestock.





From the North:

Leave the motorway (M74) at junction 14 and take the exit for the A702 Crawford/ Thornhill/A76. The A702 is a very scenic road so you'll be able to enjoy some spectacular views, but please remember to keep an eye on the road especially through the bends!

At the T-junction where the A702 meets the A76 turn left towards Thornhill. Follow the A76 through Thornhill until you get to the village of Auldgirth.

Turn left off the A76 into Auldgirth village, you should be able to see the local pub The Auldgirth Inn to your left as you turn off the A76. Turn immediately left as though heading towards the Inn. In between the Inn and the Village hall is a single-track road that runs straight up the hill, follow this road, and as you go over the hump-back railway bridge, you'll be able to see the farm.

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
